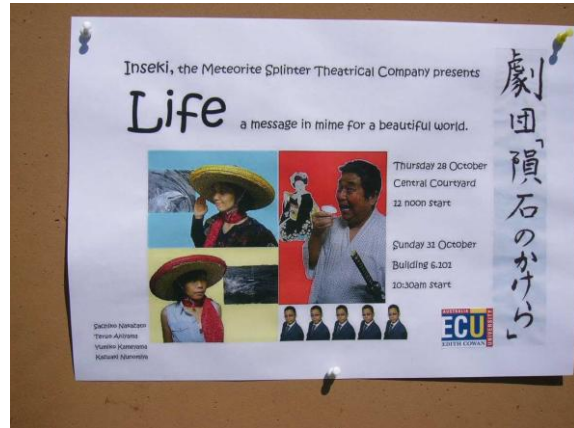


[Edwin Cowan University] October 28th

About 30 teachers and staffs watched our performance.

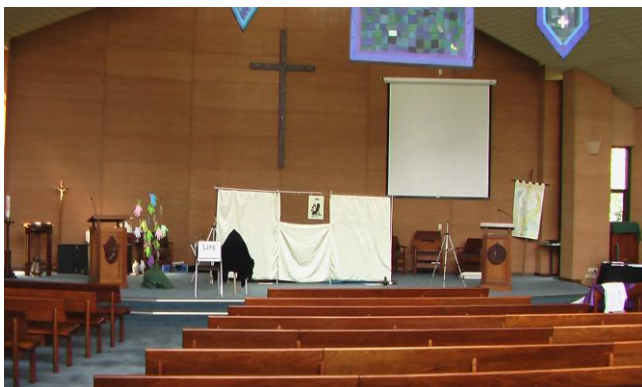
The teacher who was in charge of our performance said, "This is very good play. Your performance tells the very important message."

There were many people who stopped in front of the place for performance and watched our performance. Most people watched our performance from first to end. The audience often laughed at our performance and applauded at the end.

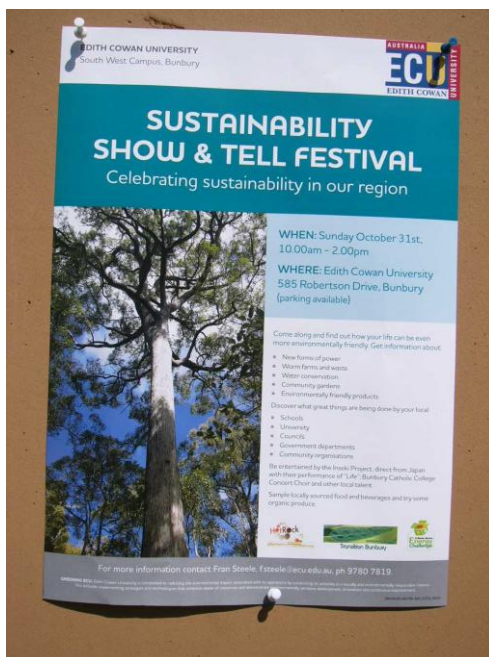


[In the Event at ECU] October 31st
